#### **Telephone or Virtual Visit Script**

- This is not an emergency. I'm Dr. Meier, is this a good time to talk?
- How has corona virus impacted you or your family?
- What have the doctors told you so far?
- May I share an update with you now?
- Would you like to do a virtual visit and see your dad with me now?

#### **Next Phase of Covid-19**

- Post hospital discharge care needs
- Approach to the many non-weanable ventilated ICU patients
- Sequelae of prolonged intubation and ICU care


### Telepalliative Covid Care

- Unique needs of Covid ICUs
- Utilization of iPads w/ families
- Goals of care conversations
  - We don't offer treatments that won't work, harm>benefit
  - Preferences
    - Intubation, ventilator
    - Artificial feeding/Trach/Nursing home
    - CPR?

## Symptom Distress

- No family or visitors
- Anxiety, depression
- Difficulty breathing
- Mechanical ventilation often requires sedation
